Once Riders have qualified for RIHS or HOYS they are no longer eligible to compete in the final. Two Rounds not against the clock. All equal first in Round one will go forward to Round Two over a shortened course Rule. Those pony / rider combinations who achieve two double clears (subject to revision) will qualify for the final to be held at the British Showjumping Scope Festival.
