The two highest placed from classes 4 – 6, 11-14, 17, 19 and 21 not already qualified, will qualify for Equifest.

In Hand Classes

Indoor Arena – Classes commencing at 9am
Judge: Justine Armstrong - Small

Class 1 Youngstock

Open to 1, 2 and 3 Year Olds. Any Breed.

Class 2 Veteran Horse And Pony

Pony – Under 148cm, Horse – Over 148cm. Class will be split if entries warrant.

Horses or Ponies 16 and over qualify for Trailblazers.

Horses or Ponies 15 and over qualify for +15

Class 3 Part Bred Horse or Pony

(Part Bred Welsh or Part Bred Arab only will qualify for Trailblazers)

Class 4 Mountain and Moorland

Open to M&M Large and Small Breeds registered with their respective Pure Breed Societies. Stallion, Mare, Colt, Filly or Gelding, any age. Class will be split if entries warrant.

Class 5 Coloured, Piebald and Skewbald Horse or Pony

Open to Paints, Spots Duns Palminos and Roans, Traditional (i.e. Feather, Full Mane and Tail, etc,) and Non Traditional. Class will be split if entries warrant. (Only Skewbald and Piebald qualify for Equifest / BSPA Qualifier)

Class 6 Riding Ponies / Show Riding Type

Show Riding Type - Under 148 cm (Trailblazer) In hand Riding Ponies, stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding. Any age but, not to exceed 153cm at maturity. (Equifest)

Class 7 Show Horse

Over 148 cm

Class 8 Hunter Horse

Class 9 Best Conditioned Horse or Pony

Class 10 Young Handlers

12 years old and under.

CHAMPIONSHIP of Classes 1 to 10

1st and 2nd from each class are eligible to compete.

Ridden Classes

Indoor Arena – Classes will not start before 1.30 p.m.

Class 11 Lead Rein

Leading Rein Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over not exceeding 122cm. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only, (incorporating Equifest Show Pony Lead Rein Qualifier). Trailblazer – 9 year olds – no height limit

Class 12 First Ridden

First Ridden Pony, mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 122 cm. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle, (incorporating Equifest Show Pony First Ridden Qualifier). Trailblazer – 9 year olds – no height limit

Class 13 Ridden Part Bred Horse or Pony

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exhibits in this section must be registered in the Part Bred Section of their respective Breed Society. Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form. Horses and ponies will not be ridden at the final. Riders any age. Trailblazer & Equifest / Yorkshire Supporters Qualifiers.

Class 14 Ridden Mountain and Moorland

Open to M&M Large and Small Breeds registered with their respective Pure Breed Societies. Class will be split if entries warrant.

Class 15 Ridden Show Type

Not exceeding 148 cm

Class 16 Ridden Thoroughbred

Including ex-racehorses

Class 17 Coloured, Piebald and Skewbald Horse or Pony

Open to Paints, Spots Duns Palminos and Roans, Traditional (i.e. Feather, Full Mane and Tail, etc.) and Non Traditional Class will be split if entries warrant. (Only Skewbald and Piebald qualify for Equifest / BSPA Qualifier)

Class 18 Ridden Veteran Horse or Pony

Horses or Ponies 16 and over qualify for Trailblazers.

Horses or Ponies 15 and over qualify for +15

Class 19 Nupafeed Riding Horse / Equifest Ridden Hacks

Open Show Hacks, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148 cm but not exceeding 160 cm. Riders any age. Open Riding Horse, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height. Riders any age. Class will be split if entries warrant.

Class 20 Ridden Cob

Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cm, (incorporating Nupafeed Ridden Cob Qualifier). Riders any age.

Class 21 Ridden Hunter

Open ridden hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over exceeding 153cms. Riders any age.

Class 22 Ridden Sports / Competition Horse

CHAMPIONSHIP of classes 11 to 22

1st and 2nd from each class are eligible to compete.

To qualify for Trailblazer second rounds, you must register as a Trailblazer Competitor which you can do on the day and costs nothing. The come and see the Secretary who will give you a letter of Congratulations which tells you how to register for the Second round.

On receipt of your completed form and £12 we will then issue you with a Qualification card which entitles you to compete at as many Second rounds as you wish, and all the participating centres will be holding one.

Rules:

1. Entries will be limited. Late entries will be accepted if space permits. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct fee.
2. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the show, alter classes, judges times or any of the published information. In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be refunded less £2.00 to cover administration costs.
3. Riding jackets, jodhpurs, and riding boots must be worn by all mounted competitors. Unmounted competitors should be correctly dressed for showing. Trainers are not allowed.
4. Correctly secured riding hats must be worn whilst mounted to the current BSI standard. It is recommended that junior handlers wear hard hats when exhibiting.
5. Please take litter home or make use of the bins provided. Please do not sweep out horse boxes onto car park area, please do it at home.
5. All dogs should be kept on leads at all times.
6. All horses or ponies, when outside the arena, should be moved at the walk only, to ensure the safety of spectators and pedestrians. No galloping allowed except as requested by a judge.
7. The judges decision is final.
8. Making an entry constitutes acceptance of these rules and conditions.
9. A judge may require that a horse/pony which constitutes a danger leaves the ring.
10. Riders must have attained their 3rd Birthday by the day of the show.
11. Horses/Ponies must be four years old and over in all ridden classes. The age should be calculated from the 1st January in the year of their birth.
12. Stallions/Colts may not be led by any juniors who have not attained their 16th Birthday before January of the current Championship Year. This will ensure that the ages of the young stock are correct for the Championship Finals.
