Class 5. 1.00m Open

Class 6. 1.05 Open

Entry fee £10 members £12 non members prize money £20, £15 £12 £8

Class 7. 1.10m Open

Entry fee £12 members £14 non members prize money £30, £20 £15 £10

Ponies will jump first followed by horses in each class.

If there are more than 30 entries in each class the class will be split with separate prizes for horses and ponies.

Prize money will be paid for 1 in every 5 competitors
(ie 5 starters 1st prize, 6-10 starters 2nd prize 11-15 starters 3rd prize and so on)
