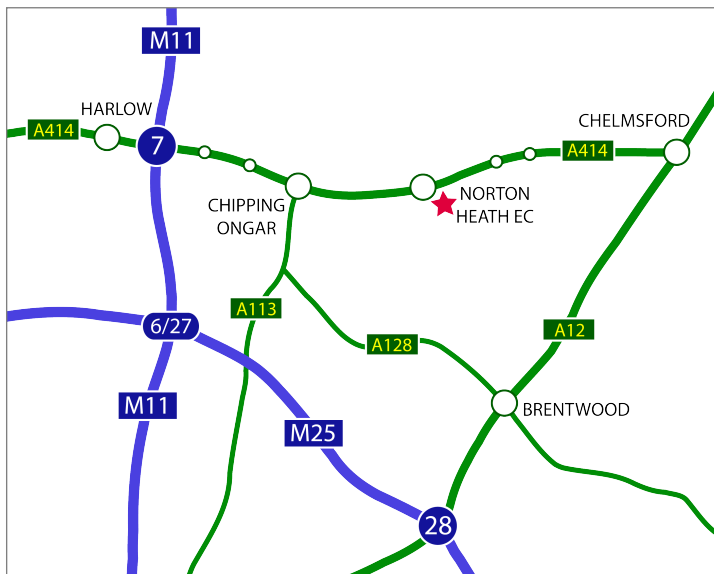

Norton Heath EC Unaffiliated Dressage League 2010/2011,
including a Championship Show and Prizes.

To qualify for our Championship Show you must
achieve a score of 60% or more. Once this score is
achieved you will be given a Congratulations
Certificate. On receipt of your completed form and
£5.00, we will then issue your Championship
Qualification Entry Form which will be needed to enter
the classes of the Championship Show.



To qualify for Trailblazer 2nd rounds, you must
register as a Trailblazer competitor which you can do
on the day and costs nothing, be eligible under
Trailblazer Rules, and achieve 58% or more. Then if you
come and see the Secretary you will be given a letter
of Congratulations which tells you how to register for
the 2nd round. On receipt of your completed form and
£12 we will then issue you with a Qualification card
which entitles you to compete at as many 2nd rounds
as you wish.

*****58%** can also qualify you for the Unaffiliated
Dressage Championships of Great Britain, to be held at
the David Broome Event Centre. Please see the
dressage secretary for a registration card

Restrictions:

Walk & Trot Riders not to have previously competed at
Novice Level or been placed First or Second at Prelim
Level.

Horses and Ponies that are **currently registered** with
British Dressage or that have been registered within the
preceding 12 months. To compete at preliminary level
must have 20 points or less, Novice level 100 points or
less, Elementary level 150 points or less – this must be
correct for both qualification rounds and
championship show.
